Blended BFA in Art Education with California Teaching Credential

If you aim to teach in California public schools, the BFA/Credential blended curriculum prepares you for the CALTPA Assessments required to earn a California teaching license. This blended program allows four undergraduate courses to count towards the credential: Overview of Art Education, Educational Psychology, Curriculum Development, and Integration of Technology. You can receive the Credential with only two additional semesters past BFA (non-Academy of Art University BFA in Art Education can apply post B.A. to the three-semester Credential Program). You can continue on after the Credential program to receive an M.A. in Teaching.

Double-Major Tracks in Art Educaton/Fine Art, Art Education/Art History

In these tracks you have the opportunity to pair a major in the School of Art Education (ARE) with an additional major in either the School of Art History (AHS) or the School of Fine Art (FA) to earn a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree (B.F.A.). The fine art track is designed to offer you a hands-on, studio-based education that will allow you to teach while establishing yourself as an artist. The art history dual degree expands your knowledge base in the underpinnings of the art world and enriches your teaching practice. These degrees are offered online only.

Capstone Projects

Our Master Programs synthesize all of your knowledge and experience with the creation of a comprehensive final Capstone project. ADVOCATE: As an M.A. teaching student, you will create a dynamic arts advocacy presentation to educate the public as to the importance of Arts Education for the 21st century creative economy.
